England goes smokefree on 1 July 2007

All enclosed public places and workplaces will be smokefree from 1 July 2007.

What smokefree will mean to employers

All enclosed public places and most work places must be smokefree, this includes; offices, factories, shops, pubs, bars, restaurants, membership clubs, public transport and work vehicles that are used by more than one person.

Signs will be required on the outside public entrances of all buildings and in company vehicles. It is anticipated that the signs for premises will have to read: 'No smoking. It is against the law to smoke in these premises', or for vehicles 'No smoking'.
